TORONTO

QUÉBEC / MONTRÉAL

Since 1985, Quebec City has been placed on the UN's prestigious World Heritage List and is a fantastic document of French Canada's struggle for survival. ROCKY MOUNTAINS

Vancouver is nestled between the sea and the mountains, a geographically picturesque area where the natural world intrudes on the bustling city. The city of new immigrants is one of North America's most cosmopolitan. Whale watch off Vancouver Island, take the cable car to the top of Grouse Mountain, visit Native Indian reserves or combine Vancouver with the American city of Seattle.
