Malta enjoys a climate which allows sports to be played all year round against local clubs and schools and, due to the large English presence, is one of the few European destinations where netball is played.

Football is the islands principal sport which is played everywhere by males and females of all ages and abilities.

The Marsa Sports & Country Club is home to the Marsa Cricket Club, this is the only pitch on the island, and is a popular destination for pre-season tours.

Hockey is still a development sport in Malta, matches are played at the National Hockey Centre, and February to April is very popular with touring sides. Please note that girl's hockey fixtures can not be arranged.

Steeped in history with year-round sunshine

Malta's capital city, Valletta, was built by the Knights of St John and is the commercial heart of the island. Its grid of narrow streets houses some of Europe's finest artworks, churches and palaces. You can wander along the side streets and browse in the little shops that sell antiques, maps and jewellery, stopping for some welcome refreshment en route at one of the many cafes dotted around the area.

The warm climate lends itself perfectly to outdoor activities and no visit would be complete without a boat trip to Malta's sister islands of Gozo and Comino which lie to the north west – perhaps stopping for a picnic lunch at the Blue Lagoon, followed by snorkelling in the clear aquamarine waters!
