St Kitts is the ideal location for teams that have previously toured the Caribbean and are looking for something a little different. The main emphasis on the island is adventure! As the islands are slightly off the beaten track, neither island is overrun with tourists, in fact you will probably see more donkeys and goats roaming around the island than people!

SPORT IN ST KITTS & NEVIS

The sport grounds are scattered around the island, so your team will get to see a lot of the island whilst transferring to fixtures. We work with the St Kitts tourist board in putting together your sport fixtures, so you are ensured professionalism from our ground staff.

The Ministry of Tourism, Sports and Culture have various sports activities running during the year. These include the schools basketball open, volleyball league, High school netball (U14's), Rams Track and Field Series, Primary cricket, netball and tennis league, football leagues, plus a summer general sports camp. WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

The Capital of St Kitts is Basseterre.

British Citizens do not require a visa to enter the country and on entry are granted a 3-week stay. Passports require 6 months validity after the return date of travel.

The local currency is Eastern Caribbean Dollar.

St Kitts is 4 hours behind GMT.

The departure tax from St Kitts is currently EC\$59.40 (approximately £12.30).

Flights into St Kitts are direct, however the return journey is via a neighbouring Caribbean Island.

Dry season is November – May.

Temperatures range from 17 to 33°C.
